Expanded shoulders to meet future capacity that will support BRT and E-Z Pass lanes


U.S. 169/TH 41/CH 78 Interchange

Removal of the traffic signal and the construction of an underpass and frontage road system eliminated safety concerns and improved mobility

St. Peter Flood Mitigation

Raising of the southbound lanes with the addition of the Hwy 22 bridge were constructed to prevent the closure of this section of Hwy 169 during flooding events

Golden Valley Improvements

Increase capacity to improve mobility and reduce congestion.

Implementation of mobility improvements from Marschall Road
Transit Station in Shakopee to Downtown Minneapolis via Hwy 55.





U.S. 169/TH 282/CR 9 Interchange




U.S. 169/TH 282/CR 9 Interchange Funding

Estimated Project Cost: \$41.1 Million Secured Funding:

- Federal Surface Transportation Program (Regional Solicitation): \$7.2 Million
- Federal RAISE Grant: \$8 Million
- Minnesota Transportation Bill: \$2.5
 Million
- MnDOT Design Funds: \$200,000

Estimated Project Cost: \$13 Million Secured Funding:

- HSIP Grant for Berkshire Ave. Extention: \$950,000
- Partnering with Scott County for pending Transportation
 Sales Tax funding
- Seeking additional LRIP and LPP funding


U.S. 169 & TH 59 Interchange

Estimated Project Cost: \$15.5 Million Secured Funding:

 Funded 100% through the Scott County Transportation Sales Tax

Timeline:

- Final Design: September 2023
- Begin Construction: Spring
 2024



- Implementation of Bus Rapid Transit on U.S. 169 via Hwy 55


Improve Safety



- Reduction of travel time


Flooding




Phases of Highway Infrastructure Phase 1 Northbo and sou improve
