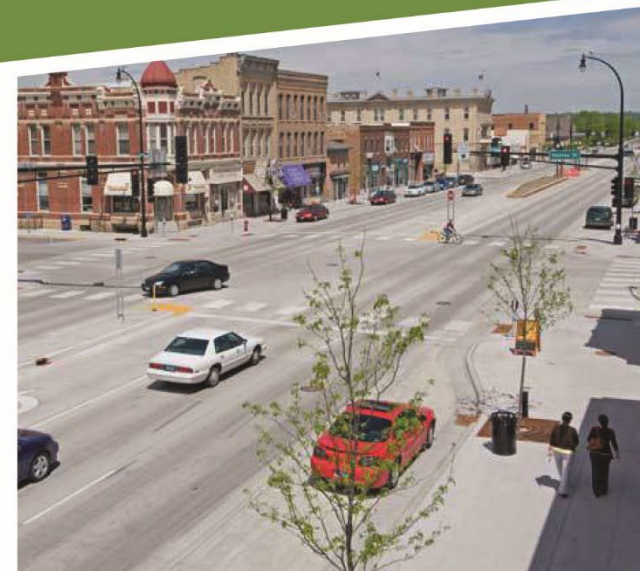

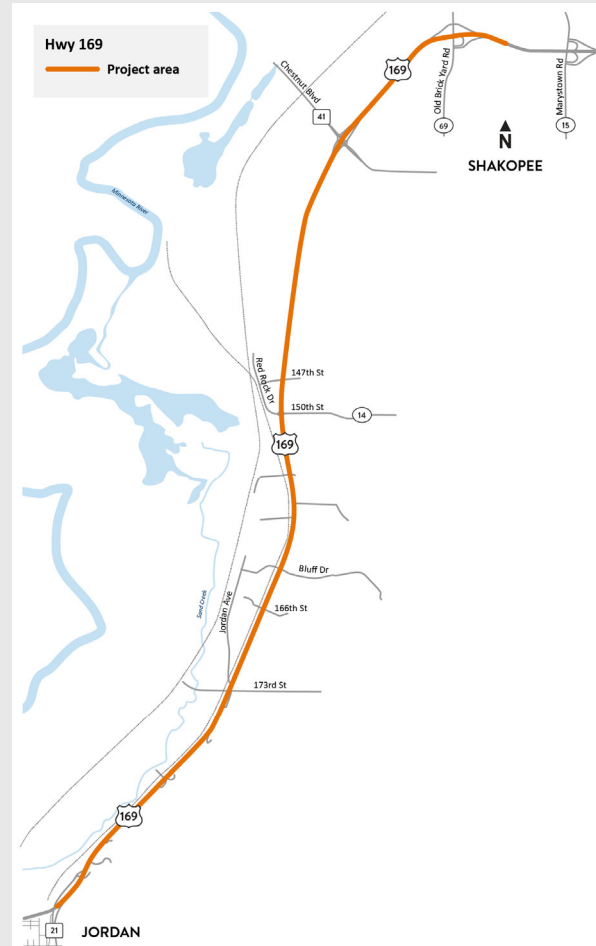

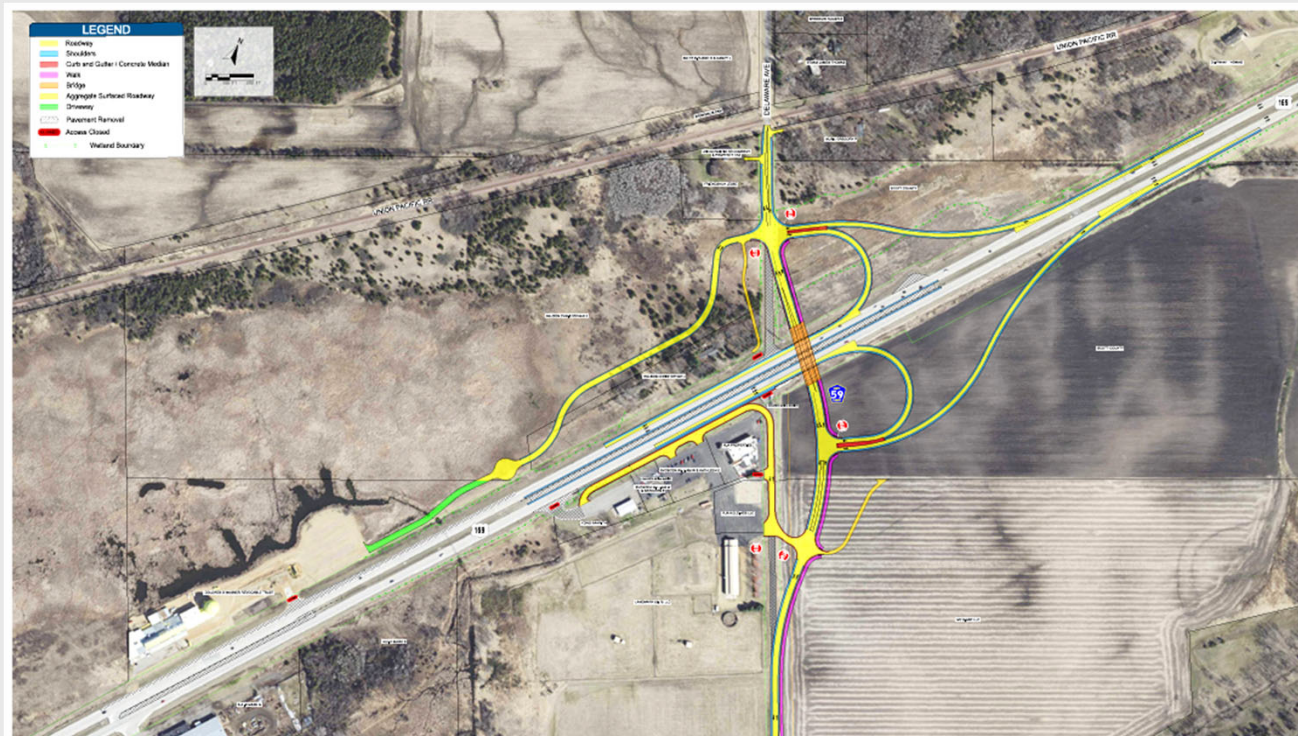

# Hwy 169 at CR 59/Delaware Ave (Scott County)

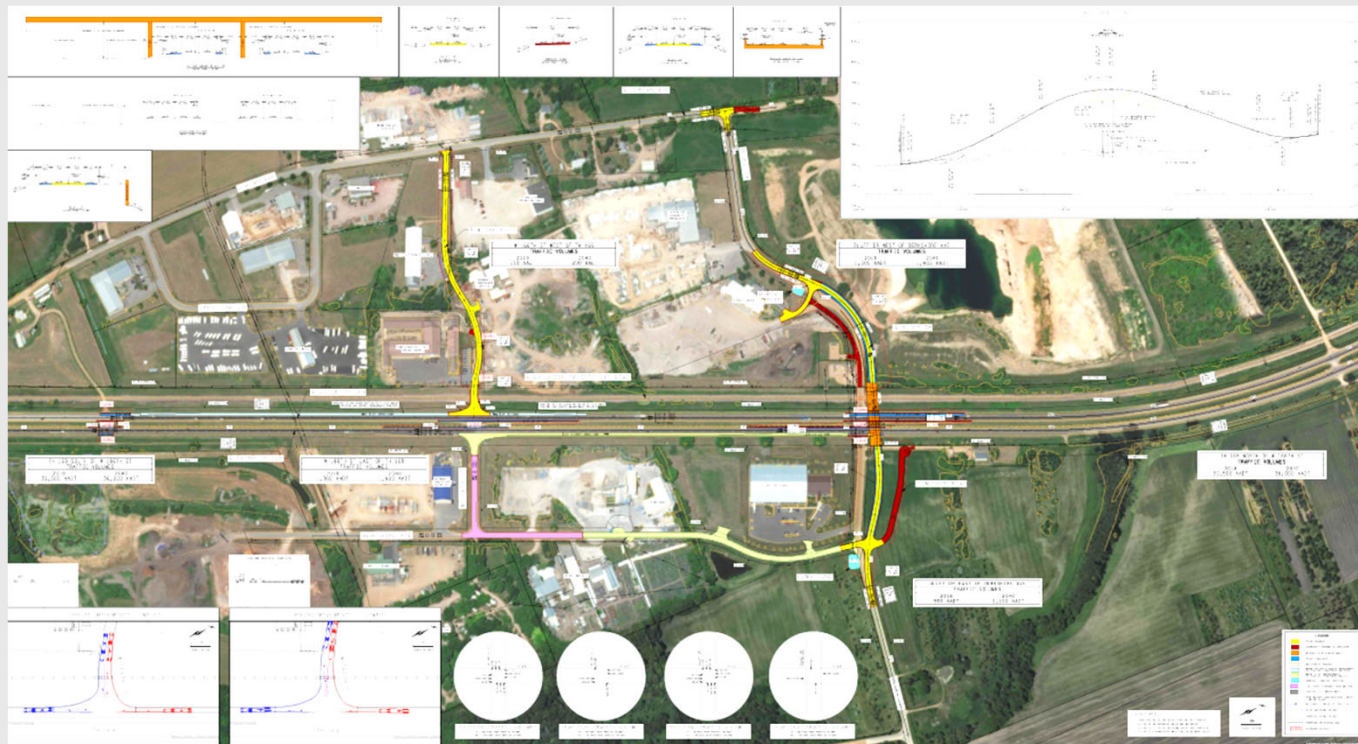
- Folded Diamond Interchange and surrounding roadway system

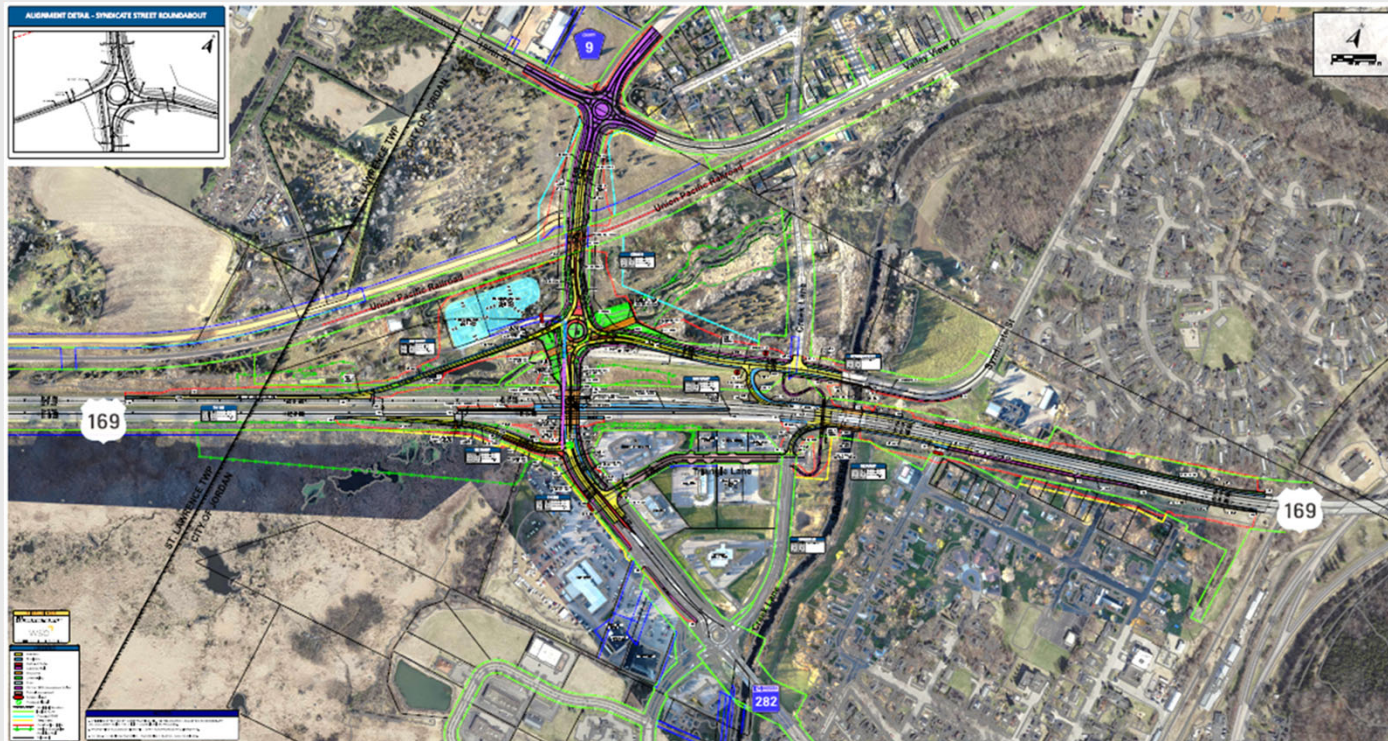

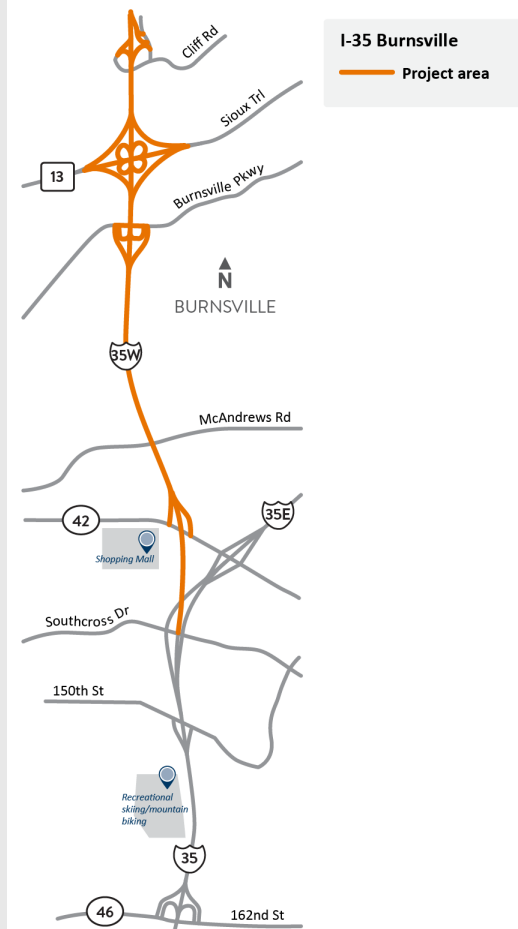

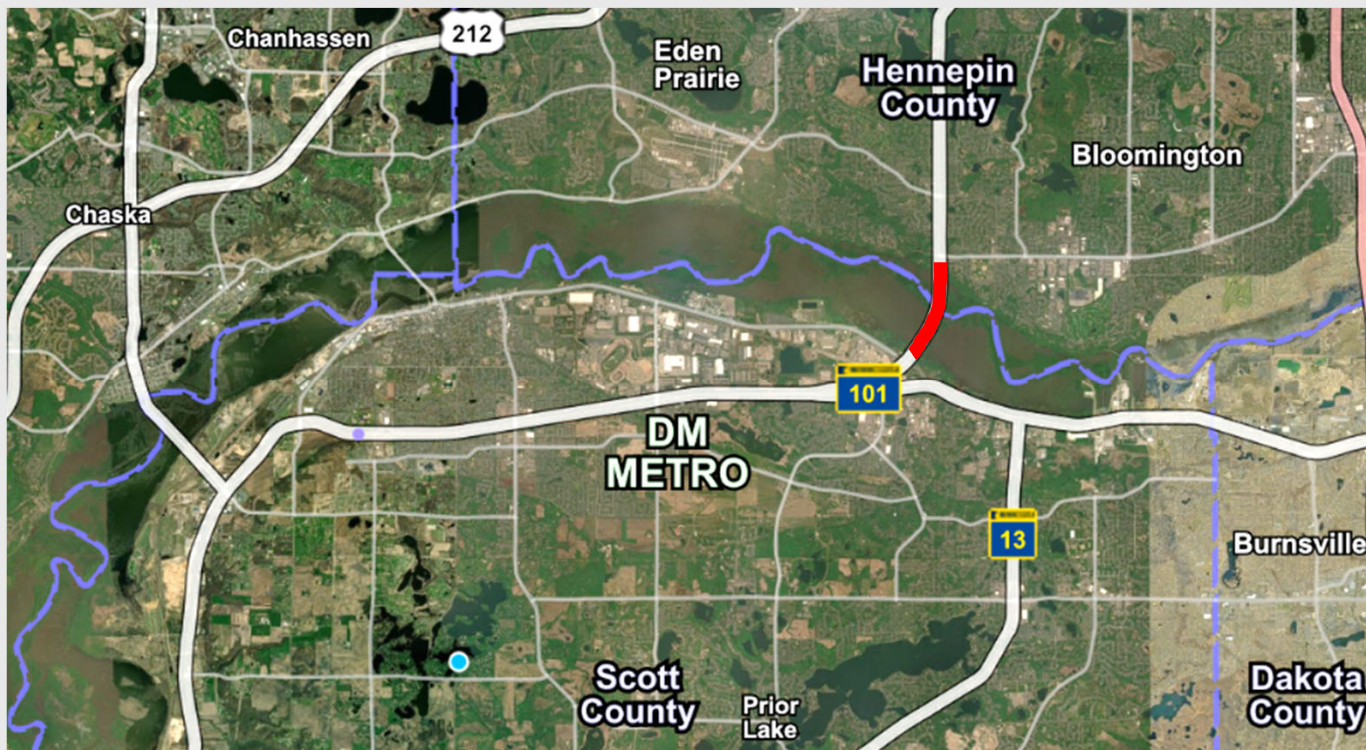

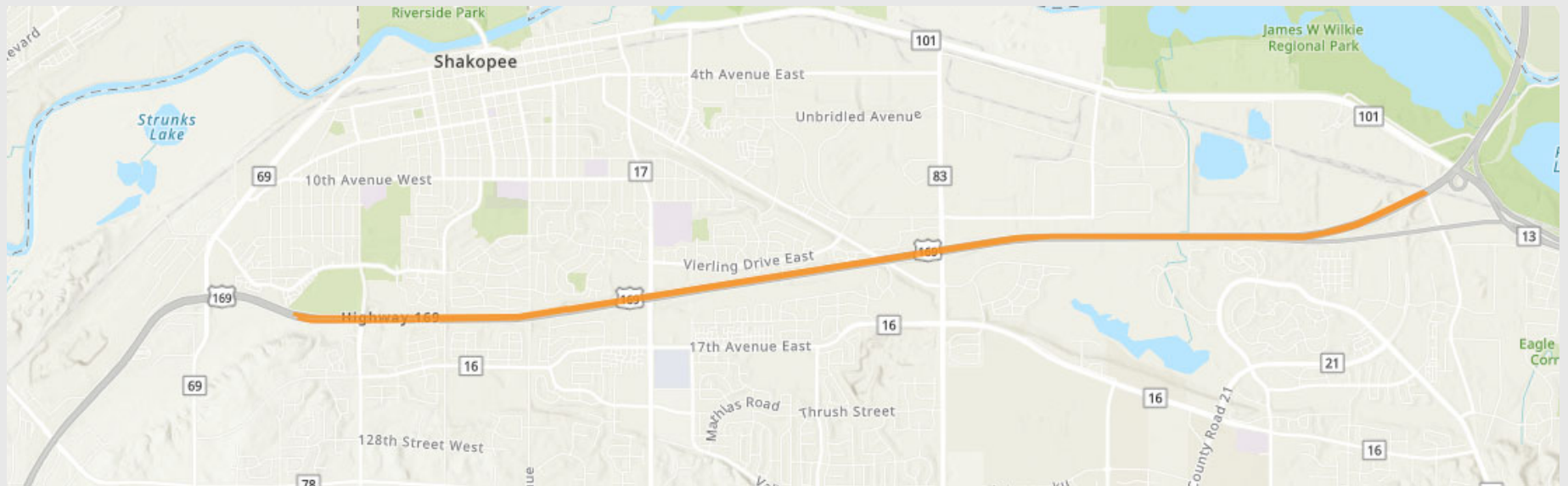

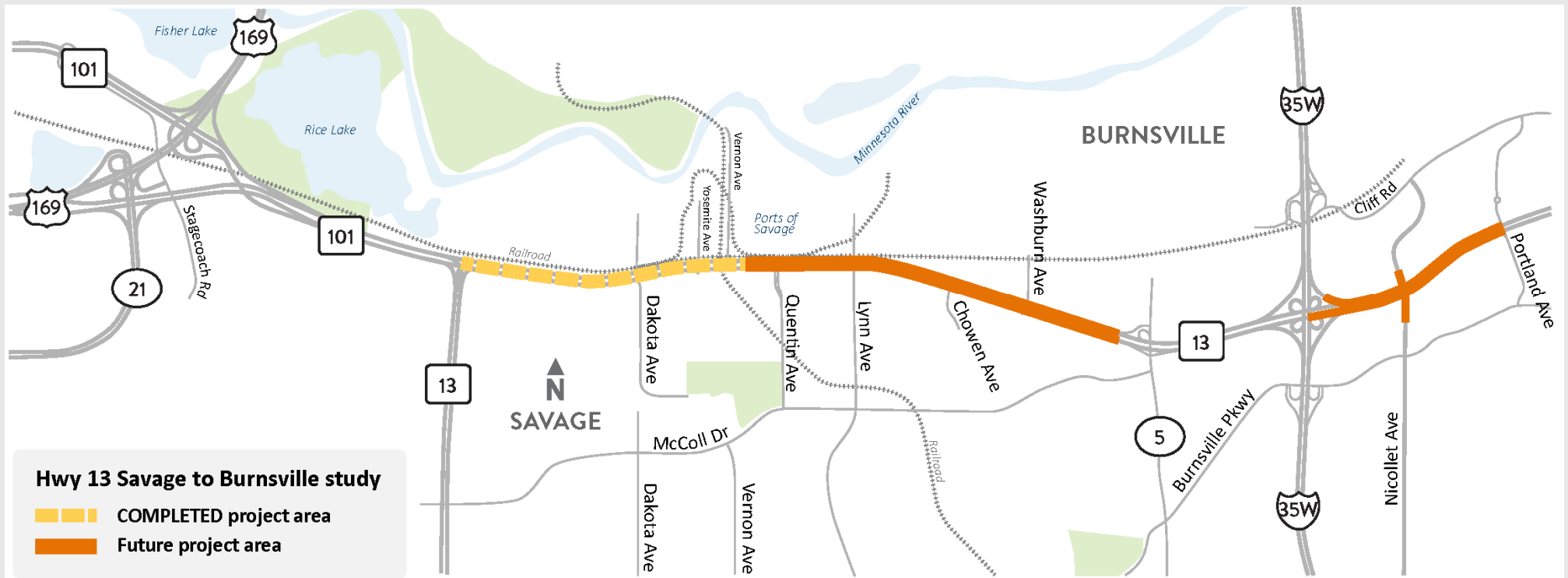
